WORKING WITH MUSLIM FAMILIES

This 1-day training course will equip practitioners to work effectively with Muslim families. Based on our well-established Nurturing Programme and Islamic Values Programme, the course specifically considers how positive parenting strategies relate to Islamic values and religious teaching. The programme



draws on Quranic verses and the Hadiths. There is an opportunity to discuss the differences between parenting styles based on cultural norms and practices, and the nurturing approach supported by Islam and the Nurturing Programme. Guidance will be offered on the most effective way to engage families and effect positive outcomes for adults and children. The training is suitable for Muslim and non-Muslim staff from all family support services, and for school and youth support staff, and is aimed at increasing the understanding and knowledge of Islam and the implications for working with Muslim families among trainees.

LEARNING OUTCOMES FOR PROFESSIONALS

✓ To develop understanding of the basic principles of Islam.

✓To understand the difference between cultural and religious practices, and explore some common misconceptions about Islam.

✓ To explore the potential barriers to working with the Muslim community and develop strategies for respectful, successful practice.

✓To develop an understanding of the Nurturing Programme approach, based on the Four Constructs: Self-awareness, Empathy, Positive Discipline, and Appropriate Expectations.

The training includes a copy of The Parenting Puzzle book and a copy of the Islamic Values and the Parenting Puzzle booklet for each trainee. The booklet draws upon the Quran and Hadiths, and is endorsed by both the Muslim Law Council and the Muslim College.


